

NO TO FRACKING – NO TO LNG!



The ITRE Committee report on the *EU strategy on LNG and gas storage* opens the door for LNG imports from countries with a large-scale fracking production that severely harms local people's health and environment, and poses a major threat to our climate.

The report supports European public subsidies for LNG infrastructure, which will lead to significant stranded assets and further fossil fuel lock-in.

Gas, particularly LNG, is **not** sustainable and **not** compatible with the Paris Agreement and EU climate objectives. There's no room for more LNG.

If the report does not recognize gas as an important cause of climate change & does not acknowledge the dangers of imported fracked gas, **we ask you to reject the report during the plenary vote on 25 October.**
