INEOS AND FRACKING – HOW WILL IT AFFECT YOU AND YOUR FAMILY?

You may not be aware of it, but you live in a Petroleum Exploration & Development Licence (PEDL) area, which has been licenced to the multinational chemicals giant INEOS.

INEOS are planning to start seismic testing and exploratory drilling in your area, with the aim of developing a fracking industry - a controversial method of extracting natural gas - on your doorstep.

INEOS plan to turn the gas they find into disposable plastic products, which are responsible for the global plastic pollution crisis, particularly in our oceans, as seen on Blue Planet 2.

Fracking will lead to the massive industrialisation of our countryside. INEOS have made no secret of their plans to establish between 10 and 15 fracking well-pads in every 6-square-mile PEDL area. Each pad could have between 10 and 50 fracking wells on it.

An individual well takes up to 120 days to drill, 24/7, and fracking can also take place day and night. Each well also requires thousands of HGV movements to bring in toxic chemicals used in fracking, and take away millions of gallons of contaminated radioactive waste water and solid waste.

INEOS are strongly resisting calls for mandatory set-back distances from fracking wells, and are happy to drill within 300m of people's homes. They have a terrible safety record – and have never fracked a single well in the UK.

Recent research from the US suggests that living within a mile of a fracking well increases your risk of heart attacks, asthma, infertility, skin and respiratory problems, miscarriage, impaired foetal growth and low birth weight.

Fracking has been banned in Scotland, Ireland, France, some states in the USA and Australia, and many other places, due to widespread health and environmental concerns.

Fracking is also likely to impact on the value of your property by up to 20%, according to recent estimates by independent surveyors - that's if you can sell it at all. Who would want to move to a gas field?
